OUR TOUR PROGRAM

July 21/Mon - USA-WARSAW. This evening we depart for Warsaw with meals and movies on board.

July 22/Tue - WARSAW. After arrival at the Okęcie Airport, we meet our guide and settle-in at the hotel situated in the heart of the city. Time free to unpack, change money and rest. Our welcome dinner is in a fine restaurant in the Old Town with typical Polish dishes and a vodka toast. On the way back to our hotel admire Warsaw by night. (D)

July 23/Wed - WARSAW - MIKOLAJKI. After buffet breakfast we get acquainted with Poland's heroic capital on a panoramic tour of the reconstructed Old Town with remnants of the defense walls, St. John's Cathedral and Royal Castle Square. At noon we depart for the picturesque Mazurian Lake region, one of Poland's favorite vacation areas. We settle-in at our resort hotel and have time to spend a fun evening at the Aqua Center. (B, D)

July 24/Thu - MIKOLAJKI - BIALYSTOK. We start the day with a relaxing boat ride followed by a visit to the beautiful Sw. Lipka sanctuary and the incredible Hitler's bunker, where assassination on his life took place in 1944. Lunch is reserved at the famous "Kiermusy" Inn. Overnight in Bialystok. (B, L)

July 25/Fri - BIALYSTOK. Today we discover the tourist attractions of the region: a weaver's workshop in Janow and a stork village. In the evening we are invited for a barbecue dinner. (B, D)

July 26/Sat - BIALYSTOK - Bialowieza - LUBLIN. After breakfast we depart South to the historic city of Lublin. En route we stop in Bialowieza, a unique primeval forest with rare bison reserve. After lunch

continue to Lublin for overnight. (B, L)

July 27/Sun - LUBLIN. Start the day with a comprehensive tour of Lublin dating back to the 13th century. It was twice the capital of Poland. Walk through the old town to the Castle Hill housing Lublin's biggest treasure, the Trinity Chapel. Have lunch at the Inn of the Ethnographic Museum of an early 9th century village. In the afternoon we visit Kozlowka Palace, splendid baroque residence of the Zamoyski family. (B, L)

July 28/Mon - LUBLIN - Zamosc - RZESZOW. This morning we depart for the renaissance town of Zamosc build in the 16th century by Italian architects. En route stop at Majdanek, martyrdom museum of the former Nazi concentration camp. After lunch we continue to Rzeszow for overnight. (B, L)

July 29/Tue - RZESZOW. After breakfast we drive to nearby Lancut to visit the magnificent baroque Palace and one of a kind Distillery Museum. In the evening enjoy a Gala concert of the XVI Festival of the Polonian Folklore Ensembles. (B, L)

July 30/Wed - RZESZOW - Zalipie - KRAKOW. Today our coach journeys to the medieval city of Krakow. After lunch in Debno Castle, we continue to the famous painted village in Zalipie. In the evening, we tour the fascinating Underground Museum invading the life in medieval Krakow. (D, L)

July 31/Thu - KRAKOW - Czestochowa - WARSAW. This morning our coach returns to Warsaw for our final overnight with a stop in Czestochowa.

Aug. 1/Fri - WARSAW-U.S.A. Early morning we depart for the airport and fly home.

4-DAY EXTENSION TO SOUTHERN POLAND, July 31 - August, 4, 2014

Krakow • Zakopane • Auschwitz • Wadowice • Czestochowa

July 31/Thu - KRAKOW - Wieliczka. Today we see Krakow in depth. Poland's capital for four centuries, Krakow is a treasure house of medieval art and architecture and one of the few cities not destroyed during WWII. A walking tour through the Old Town includes the St. Mary's Church, Cloth Hall with multitude of souvenir shops and the University's courtyard. Tour the imposing Wawel Castle and Cathedral where Polish kings were crowned and buried. In the afternoon we drive to Wieliczka, the oldest salt mine in Europe. Here on 1.3 mile tourist route admire the salt formed grottoes, lakes, chambers and the magnificent St. Kinga Cathedral. Return to Krakow for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

Aug. 1/Fri - KRAKOW-Zakopane. After breakfast, we depart for the resort of Zakopane hidden in the soaring Tatra Mountain with unique architecture and folklore of the mountaineers, "Gorale". Admire the breathtaking views of the Tatras from the Gubalowka Mountain where we can also shop for

souvenirs of arts and crafts of the Highlanders at a local bazaar. Then on to the Pieniny National Park where you can enjoy a scenic ride on rafts on the Dunajec River. (B, L)

Aug. 2/Sat - KRAKOW - Auschwitz. This morning we depart for Auschwitz, former Nazi concentration camp now a martyrdom museum, a grim reminder of the holocaust. Continue on to Wadowice, birthplace of bl. Pope John Paul II where we see his baptismal font in the parish church next to his house. Return to Krakow for balance of the day at leisure and last minute souvenir shopping or just relaxing. (B, L)

Aug. 3/Sun - KRAKOW - Czestochowa - WARSAW. After breakfast, we depart for Czestochowa, Poland's national shrine. Pauline Father will introduce us to the Jasna Gora Monastery and its treasures. After lunch, continue to Warsaw. (B, L)

Aug. 4/Mon - WARSAW - U.S.A. Early morning we depart for the airport and fly home. (B)

Due to limited space on the flights, reservation deadline is March 15, 2014

TOUR COST INCLUDES:

TOUR CONDITIONS

RESERVATIONS/PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$200 per person is required at the time of booking. Full payment is due June 6, 2014 payable by check. Price of the tour includes a built-in discount of 2% for payment by cash or check. There is no discount on credit card sales. Payment for the airline tickets must be made at the time of reservation.

TOUR COST: Tour price is based on group airfares and currency exchange levels in effect at the time of printing. It is subject to adjustment in the event of significant changes in the exchange levels or any fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines.

TOUR/AIR ARRANGEMENTS: Every effort will be made to provide flight for lowest fare available at the time of booking. Approximate cost of a round trip air transportation is \$1,400-1,500 per person.

Hotel accommodations will be provided in double or twin bedded rooms with private bath. Single rooms are available at the supplement shown. While every effort will be made to provide sharing of accommodations for persons booking alone, when requested, it cannot be guaranteed and single supplement must be paid before departure when billed. Triple rooms are not available.

Unused hotel accommodations or any other unused features of this tour are not refundable or exchangeable for other services. The right is reserved to substitute hotels and sightseeing features if it becomes necessary.

Each tour member must be able to get on and off

the motorcoach unaided and not require walking devices or wheelchairs. Children under 7 are not accepted on motorcoach tours.

NOT INCLUDED IN THE TOUR COST: Air transportation, cost of passports, items of a personal nature; phone calls, laundry, optional insurance, additional meals/beverages, gratuities to the tour guide and driver.

BAGGAGE: Free baggage allowance is one suitcase not exceeding 50 lbs. measuring 62 in. (sum of three sides) and one carry-on bag not exceeding 18 lbs and measuring 45 in. (sum of three sides).

NO VACCINATIONS are required by law.

DOCUMENTS: A valid U.S. or foreign passport is required. To apply for passport, contact your local Post Office. Check the validity of your passport. Passport should be valid for at least three months after your return date.

LAND TOUR CANCELLATIONS: All cancellations must be made in writing to PAT TOURS. Full refund will be made for cancellations received up to 46 days prior to departure less a \$25 administrative fee. Between 45 - 36 days deposit of \$200 is non-refundable. No refund will be made for cancellations received less than 35 days prior to departure.

AIRLINE TICKETS, when issued, are subject to the airline cancellation policy applicable to the airfare used. After completion of the tour, claims for refund must be made in writing within 30 days.
